

Child Protection Policy for Visitors

We thank you for your interest in and support of BAAN DOI. As we are an organization committed to the protection of children, we have our Child Protection Policy and Code of Conduct to ensure all children under our care are safe and protected according to the Convention on Child Rights. The rules and regulations for visitors and guests as outlined below are an important part of the BAAN DOI Child Protection Policy.

BAAN DOI permits you to:

1. Visit and interact with the children of BAAN DOI in the common area (after meeting with our BAAN DOI team)
2. Bring the children presents, but you should pass them to the BAAN DOI staff to handle the distribution
3. Participate in the children's activities under the guidance of our staff
4. Join the children for lunch or dinner, but advanced notice is recommended

BAAN DOI asks for your cooperation to not:

1. Touch the children without their permission or touch them inappropriately
2. Be alone with a child without a BAAN DOI staff present
3. Invite or take the children out of BAAN DOI, or invite the children to your place of residence. If you wish to do so, a request must be made through BAAN DOI and if granted, at least one BAAN DOI staff must accompany the child/children.
4. Take photos/videos of the children without their permission. If you wish to take pictures you must inform the staff
5. Take photos/videos of individual children. Group pictures and pictures of children's participation in activities are allowed for private use
6. Upload pictures/videos on websites or social media. If you wish to do so you must get the permission of BAAN DOI's staff
7. Mentioning of "children living with HIV/AIDS" will not be stated on websites, Facebook or other online media, but the personal disclosure of such information is at the children's discretion only
8. Exchange address, email or social media accounts with the children. Any contact must be made through BAAN DOI
9. Give money to the children directly or individually
10. Inquire about their details or disclose of their information without consent
11. Enter their sleeping quarters, showers, or toilets without permission
12. The consumption of cigarettes and alcohol is not allowed in the area of the orphanage. The consumption of illegal drugs will be reported to the police
